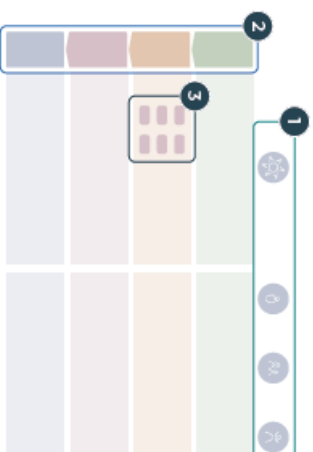


These maps provide an eagle's view over Child and Family wellbeing services across Kununurra, Wyrndham, Halls Creek, and Warmun and the East Kimberley.

The purpose of these maps is to provide greater visibility of services so that is easier to know what is available and how to access them.

## How to use these maps

- 1 Identify relevant family type  
 Look across the top of the maps to find your relevant mob - family, bubs, kids, or teens.
- 2 Identify stage  
 Empower > Respond > Crisis > Restore. Each of these stages represent the different needs of families or children and the support available. Pick the stage that you think you are currently in.
- 3 Identify service step  
 Within your section of the map, the services are colour coded according to their location in the East Kimberley. Scan through the services to see what's available in your area.



## Key

- Map A
- Family / mob: Services that support all members of the family
  - Bubs (0-5 yrs): Services that support new borns, babies, toddlers and small children
  - Little ones (6-11 yrs): Services that support older children, primary age and pre teens
  - Teens (12-17 yrs): Services that support young people

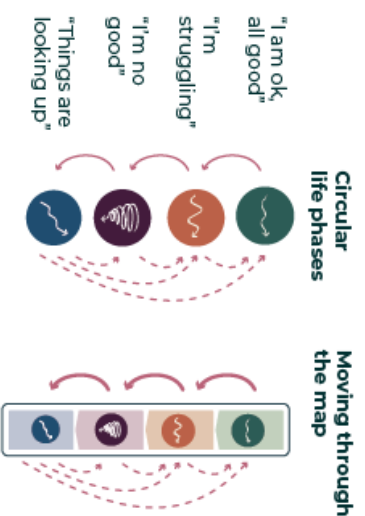
## Moving through the map : Life phases

Life is a cycle and you move back and forth through these phases:

As you or your family identify your needs for services or support you can move through different phases of the map if your needs get more serious.

If your needs or crisis de-escalate or pass, you will cycle back up the map to the 'empower' services.

There is no linear order for moving through these services. Use this map to help you navigate and find what best fits your context.

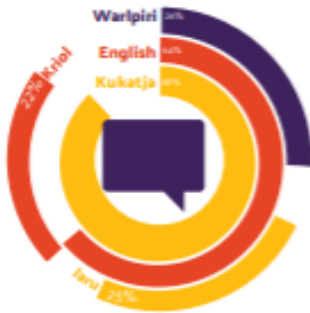
